AWARD Overview

The **Community Resilience Award** is awarded to an individual in public service who actively works towards the betterment and progress of our area through their perseverance and dedication to the betterment of society.

General Award Eligibility

- Nominees must be from the Greater Wyoming Valley Area.
- Nominee must be employed or volunteering within the public sector or civil service. (Examples include: First Responders, Educators, Military)

Selection Criteria - Each answer should consist of 2-4 paragraphs for consideration:

- 1. Nominator Contact Information: Name, Company, Title, Business Phone, E-mail Address, City, State, Zip
- 2. Nominee's Contact Information (Professional): Name, Company, Title, Business Phone, E-mail Address, City, State, Zip
- 3. How does this individual uphold the highest standards of ethics and integrity in their work, consistently acting with honesty and accountability in all actions related to public service?
- 4. What direct initiatives does the nominee demonstrate towards improving the lives of others in the community?

- 5. How does the nominee collaborate with other people/organizations or local groups to achieve common objectives?
- 6. Give an example of how the nominee through their leadership, guides and motivates others to work toward a common goal.
